Yes, absolutely, and it's only if, when you stop and think of what does perhaps being in Europe mean to you, and do you consider yourself European, or English, or French perhaps, or Dutch ... and then it's only when the question actually arises, it makes you stop and think of the change that you have made in your life by coming here .
