- Yves I am president of Passion of Loudeac since thirty years. The Passion of Loudeac has play for first time in 1914 and since all years we play four or five plays? each year. The Passion is representation of the last days of Jesus.
- Rob. The last days of Jesus on earth.
- Yves. Yes. In the, the Passion of Christ we begin, yes, begin for Jerusalem, Jerusalem and the.... then Crucifixion and Resurrection of Jesus.
- Rob. This is a Passion play which you present what, in a theatre or in the street ?
- Yves. In a theatre, it's not in the street. It's in theatre at Loudeac is Palais des Congrès. It's a theatre of eight hundred spectators.
- Rob. Are there many people taking part ? Are many actors in the play ?
- Yves. When we are two hundred and fifty person in Association and actors, we will have one hundred and eighty person.
- Rob. One hundred and eighty actors on stage ?
- Yves. Actors, yes, yes.
- Rob. It must be a great spectacle.
- Yves. I, I, I think it's a big spectacle. We, uh, sorry (*French: nous sommes parti d'une Association multinationales*)
- Rob. We're part of an international group.
- Yves His name is 'La Groupe Passion ' and today we are one hundred and twenty Passion in Europe.
- Rob So there are a hundred and twenty groups of performers in many countries
- Yves And now we speak in English, excuse, excuse me because I speak very, very little English, excuse me, huh? If English person come to see at Loudeac, it's not a problem because the people know the history of Jesus for the last days of Jesus.
- Rob So the presentation in Loudeac, at Easter, will be in French, but the story will be very clear.

Yves French, yes, yes, yes.

Rob And, uh, is there singing as well ? Is there....

Yves Music, CD, CD Rom, CD enregistered (recorded) by Chorale of St Brieuc is specially for spectacle. It's very, very, very, very good.

Rob. Can you tell us when you will be presenting the play ?

Yves This year's six, the sixth, thirteen and twenty March.

Rob The sixth, the thirteenth, the twentieth of March.

Yves The Sunday, fifteen, fifteen hours, yes OK.

Rob The play begins at fifteen hundred hours, at three o'clock in the afternoon.

Yves Afternoon, yes, OK.

Rob And is it a long show ?

Yves Two, two hours, two hours and half.

Rob Two and a half hours.

Yves Yes.

Rob I understand that you have a website where people can look at the show beforehand and maybe, perhaps, buy tickets ?
