



Leclerc Exhibition Centre, Landerneau

Rob: And I am in the lovely town of Landerneau in the courtyard of a very old building talking to Katell Monsec. I notice the name Leclerc so it obviously is linked with the supermarket.

Rob: And it is going to be less of an art gallery then, more of a performance space.

Catal: Yes, for this third exhibition it will be like a performance.

Rob: When will this exhibition be on?

Catal: It will be on by the 10th of April until the 16th of May, so just five weeks.

Rob: I can see there are a lot of people, you can hear a lot of people including children in the courtyard here. You have a lot of visitors?

Catal: Yes, we have hundreds of visitors, each, each day. Yes, we can, we can say that.

Rob: The Museum is going to be open every day during the summer with this exhibition of Chagall?

Catal: Yes, exactly.

Rob: Opening times?

Catal: From 10 - 7 June, July and August and from 10 - 6 in September and

October.

Rob: OK. I think we will try and organise a visit from our group.

Catal: Yes, of course.

Rob: And, you can show us around.

Catal: Yes.
